Boston Public Garden


America's first botanical garden, this oasis in the city boasts a colorful array of trees and flowers. This spectacular scene has made the area one of the greatest attractions in Boston.

- Centrally located in Boston's vibrant go-to destination for entertainment in an area bustling with performing arts venues, nightclubs, bars, and restaurants


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

FENWAY BOSTON'S PLAYGROUND

This neighborhood, offically recognized as Fenway-Kenmore, is one of the most lively districts in the city. Home to several Boston icons, such as the famous Citgo sign, Kenmore Square, and The Art Institute of Boston, the immediate neighborhood is a quite prominent destination for locals and visitors alike. The district is perhaps most recognized for Fenway Park (home to the Red Sox, MLB), which is the oldest and among the most beloved ballparks in Major League Baseball. In addition to MLB games, Fenway Park hosts other athletic competitions and major concerts all year round. Also in the Fenway-Kenmore neighborhood are several schools for higher education, including Boston University, Northeastern University, and Wheelock College. This versatile district attracts a very wide range of crowds during all times of the year. Fenway Park



- Located directly across from PwC Corporate headquarters and surrounded by Gillette's world headquarters, Thomson Reuters, and General Electric allows this impactful display to reach a high volume of commuters and office workers with disposable income


